Peer Review of Thailand's Competition Law and Policy

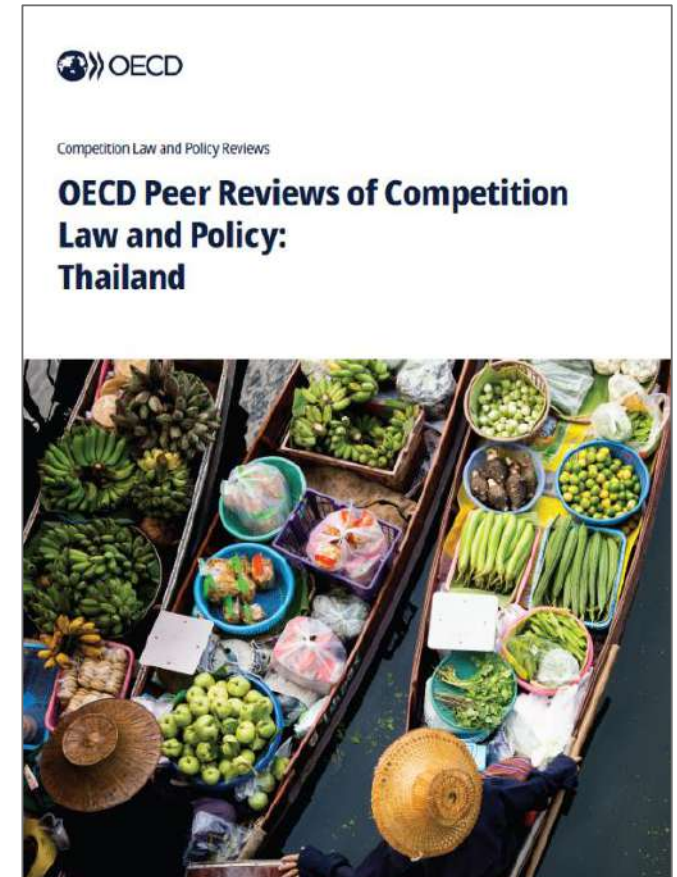
- Questionnaire (December 2024)

- Examination session during the OECD Global Forum on Competition (December 2024)
- Approval of recommendations by peers (January 2025)
- Launch of the final report (2 May 2025)





Peer Review of Thailand's Competition Law and Policy

- Key recommendations:
 - Further aligning anti-cartel enforcement and merger review with international best practices
 - Ensuring that competition rules apply equally to all types of enterprises to support fair and open competition
 - Enhancing transparency of competition enforcement procedures and decisions
 - Boosting the efficiency and resources of the competition authorities to increase its impact
- Implementing the Peer Review recommendations will also help Thailand further align with OECD standards as it embarks on the OECD accession process
