Preparing for the Govt. of the Future (Net Zero Readiness)

- Workshop for the Thai public sector to support Net Zero policies (Dec 2023)
- Capacity-building workshop and group discussions across 5 key sectors (Energy, IPPU, Waste, Agriculture & Transportation) (April 2025)
- Status: OECD to finalize a review report by Sep 2025

Integrity & Ethics Enhancement

- Reduce corruption risks
- Foster a better, trusted, and transparent governance
- Measures: Coordinating OECD recommendations with relevant agencies (e.g., Office of the National Anti-Corruption Commission (ONACC) and Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC))



Open & Connected Government

- Foster citizen and stakeholder engagement
- Shift role from "Service provider" to "Facilitator"
- Enhanced data interoperability
- Initiatives:
 - 1. PPP Saraburi Sandbox: A Low Carbon City
 - 2. PPP Tackling PM2.5 Pollution
 - 3. Idea4Gov Platform
