

**REGULATION OF THE OFFICE OF THE PRIME MINISTER  
ON THE SUPERVISORY COMMITTEE OF THE OECD  
ACCESSION PROCESS OF THAILAND B.E. 2569 (2026)**

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Whereas accession to the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) is an important national policy, and such accession process requires cooperation between the public and private sectors in order to clearly determine the direction and framework for implementation, as well as to promote a common understanding among all relevant sectors and enable them to work together efficiently, in a unified manner, and continuously until completion of the process;

By virtue of section 11 (8) of the State Administration Act B.E. 2534 (1991), the Prime Minister, with the approval of the Council of Ministers, hereby issues the following Regulation:

**Clause 1.** This Regulation shall be called the ‘Regulation of the Office of the Prime Minister on the Supervisory Committee of the OECD Accession Process of Thailand, B.E. 2569 (2026)’.

**Clause 2.** This Regulation shall come into force as from the day following the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.

**Clause 3.** In this Regulation:

‘OECD’ means the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development;

‘Committee’ means the Supervisory Committee of the OECD Accession Process of Thailand;

‘Chairperson’ means the Chairperson of the Supervisory Committee of the OECD Accession Process of Thailand;

‘member’ means a member of the Supervisory Committee of the OECD Accession Process of Thailand;

‘State agency’ means a government agency, local government administration, State enterprise, public organisation, and any other State agency.

**Clause 4.** There shall be a committee called the ‘Supervisory Committee of the OECD Accession Process of Thailand’, consisting of:

**Clause 5.** A meeting of the Committee shall require the attendance of not less than one half of the total number of members to constitute a quorum.

At a meeting of the Committee, if the Chairperson is not present or is unable to perform the duties, a Vice-Chairperson, in order of precedence, shall preside over the meeting. If no Vice-Chairperson is

present or is able to perform the duties, the members present shall elect one among themselves to preside over the meeting.

A decision of the meeting shall be made by a majority of votes. Each member shall have one vote. In the event of an equality of votes, the person presiding over the meeting shall have an additional vote as a casting vote.

**Clause 6.** The Committee shall have the following duties and powers:

(1) to formulate policies, recommend guidelines for the implementation of Thailand's accession to the OECD, and direct and supervise such implementation in accordance with the criteria, conditions, and Thailand's OECD Accession Roadmap;

(2) to appoint subcommittees to assist in the performance of the duties of the Committee as necessary and appropriate;

(3) to invite representatives of State agencies, the private sector, civil society, or relevant persons to attend a meeting in order to provide explanations, recommendations, or opinions beneficial to the performance of the duties of the Committee, as necessary and appropriate;

(4) to perform any other act as entrusted by the Prime Minister or the Council of Ministers.

**Clause 7.** Expenses for meeting allowances, remuneration, and expenses relating to the operation of the Committee and subcommittees may, as the case may be, be disbursed in accordance with official regulations, as follows:

(1) expenses of the Committee shall be disbursed from the budget of the Office of the National Economic and Social Development Council;

(2) expenses of a subcommittee shall be disbursed from the budget of the agency to which the secretary of such committee is attached.

**Clause 8.** The Prime Minister shall have charge and control of the execution of this Regulation.
